MOVE will provide a quantitative integrated database on European youth mobility

## Analysis

MOVE will analyse mobility of young people in the EU and generate systematic knowledge about young people's mobility patterns

## Reflection

## Recommendation

MOVE will give research-informed recommendations on how mobility of young people can be 'good' both for socio-economic development and for individual development
